Location: B. Competition Section, 1. Awarding and Sanctioning of Meets

Proposed By: David White

Purpose: As an LSC we should be trying to consolidate as much of our top talent as possible into our high-level LSC meets. This change will ensure that we can get most of our top talent competing at our LSC championship meets, instead of diluting the playing field with conflicting meets.

Effective: September 1st, 2023

The meet schedule is developed by the Technical Planning Committee. Clubs wishing to submit a bid for meet must complete the bid form found on the NJS web site by the date determined by the Technical Planning Committee.

Proposed Addition: Effective 9/1/2023

Sanctioned meets can conflict with other meets. However, to reduce the risk of diluting the competitive pool of swimmers, meets will have time standard restrictions when on the same weekends as NJSwim Championship Series Meets, as follows:

- On the weekends of NJSwim Senior Champs and Junior Olympics, conflicting meets must have a No Faster Than standard equivalent to the Gold Standard Cuts
- On the weekends of NJSwim Silver and/or Bronze Championships, conflicting meets must have a No Slower Than standard equivalent to the Silver and/or Bronze Standard Cuts, whichever is the fastest meet on those weekends

An exception to this conflict rule will be made for YMCA-affiliated meets that wish to be sanctioned by NJSwim in order to get times into SWIMS database (i.e. Y Championship Meets).
